<p>In some situations, the instances of Firefox will start and not quite know what to do. For example, the network is down or something. Also, there is usually a moment or two between starting Firefox and the Java process being able to tell it what to do. In this situation, Firefox starts with a message that starts with, "Well, this is embarrassing." Too smart by half, Firefox is!</p> <p>The fix for this is to manipulate the configuration of each instance of Firefox. This is tedious, but simple.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Start Firefox in safe mode, and using the profile of each instance that may be used<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ firefox -safe-mode -PDynamicDisplay◦ firefox -safe-mode -PDynamicDisplay22. In the address bar, go to the address, "about:config"3. Search for "browser.sessionstore.resumefromcrash" on the page4. Click on this line so that the value turns to "false"5. Exit Firefox6. restart the Display software.
