If one accesses the elog with http://... or without http at all the elog will not properly log the user in when they attempt to. Once someone accesses the elog using https://it magically works thereafter, even after the browser is closed and regardless of the url typed. I believe this may have always existed. It appears to be a bug with IE and not the elog
