It would be nice to be able to tag a log or category based on the text from the entry. eg. #Booster would like to access to work on a #vacuum issue. This example would tag the booster log and the vacuum category but present the entry without the tag character, whatever it may be.

A variant of this I'd like to see would be a 'suggested log' and 'suggested category' feature.

For example if one types "BRF15 RFGE Faults" the log would propose Booster and RF as categories.

Similarly, one could extend this idea to device names "I:IP1052 tripped off, reset" and automatically suggest Main Injector from the "I:" substring.

Basically a suite of regexes to help categorize typical notes.

Perhaps these sorts of ideas could be better implement in a sort of "Elog Enhancement Suite", that way it could be kept separate from the log code and not forced upon all users.
