Infinite Scroll does not work with Ascending Time Sorts

Description

When sorting by Creation Date - ASC, Modified Date - ASC and Entry ID - ASC if one reaches the bottom of the page the infinite scroll feature always reports "No entries found", even if there are more entries.

For example, when one scrolls to the bottom of these 50 entries, the Elog should find the next 50 and populate them:

Instead only "No entries found" is displayed.

Sorting by Save Count - ASC and Is Memo - ASC appear to work correctly. This appears to only be a problem with sorts that have reversed temporal order, i.e. the infinite scroll should be looking for newer entries rather than older ones.
