Higher number = fewer metrics sent to the metric storage</pre> <p>I am going to replace this with the following, which is used as the fhiCL::Comment for that parameter:</p> <pre>The verbosity level threshold for this plugin. sendMetric calls with verbosity level greater than this will not be sent to the plugin.</pre>
