Chrome starts stopping insecure links from within https pages.

this was raised in <https://github.com/glideinWMS/glideinwms/issues/34>

I noticed that the latest version of Chrome blocks the loading of jquery in the frontend's web interface. This is because it is linked over http:// even when https:// is used to to load the page. Here's an example link:

Can we always load this resource over HTTPS?

The solution is to make those links protocol agnostic so they will work w/ both http and https
