#### Description

We had a few incidents where a validation script got stuck, and we hit the Grid batch system wallclock limits before Condor got started.

This is obviously unacceptable, but we currently have no good means for preventing it.

We should thus add a timeout in glidein\_startup.sh, and if a script does not terminate on time, it is killed and considered failed.
