Currently the FTS uses a single work queue for all metadata operations. This means that if you are processing a very large number of files, no declarations of new files will happen until the database has been queried for all discovered file names, because the declares are added at the end of the queue. There isn't any need for this, so declaring files should use a separate work queue.
