An example from the other day:

Negative numbers for retire time are a bit confusing. I'd prefer to shorten the retire time to zero, skip the spread calculation, and add a line in the script that the job aborted because the proxy wasn't long enough (probably because the max job time is longer than the proxy lifetime).
