Currently, frontend monitoring shows what it knows about the requests, how many resources have been provisioned and what the limits are. However it does not tell what factory is doing with the requests, how many glideins have been submitted etc. All this info is in the glideresource classads, we need to capture it in the rrd and make a monitoring page displaying this information. This is frontend equivalent of factory status now web page.
