#### Description

Currently, a product name (before it is set up) appears to be its directory name which may have "-" in it. The version file also has the product name which appears to become the "product name" (for unsetup, if setupEnv is in the table file). There can, manually, be a switch from "-" to "\_" at this point. To unsetup the product, the "name" with "\_" must be used.

It seems to me that the unsetup command could be made to take either name. In other words, always perform a translation from "-" to "\_" when looking for the appropriate SETUP\_PRODUCT\_NAME environment variable.

There is the whole issue of case sensitivity --- i.e. a ups database may have 2 product which differ only by case, but only one of these products can be setup at a time. The dash <-> underscore is related -- one could view an "\_" as the upper case version of "-".
