#### Description

When adding an entry the subject field autocomplete displays the 10 most "relevant" subject tags as decided by the Elog DB lexeme search. This doesn't always give good results for example "Tuner [#51](#)" doesn't appear in the autocomplete because there is a subject tag for Tuners 1-51.

It may be beneficial to do a compound sort on relevance and date added.
