It would be really really useful at this point to be able to cut-and-paste images into the logbook
At present, we have many utilities that let us copy images from web browsers or other applications, but to upload to the elog the only recourse we have is screenshot->file->file upload. That's clumsy and means that people will be lazy about posting images as a result. Many web apps have cut-and-paste capabilities, like google docs or gmail or imgur or similar. The Clipboard API spec is now supported in most browsers (including the standard Firefox on linux desktops) and so supporting this should not be too burdensome.
